RAF BRINGS SERVICES TO THE COMMUNITIES OF MALAMULELE, 8 DECEMBER.

The Road Accident Fund (RAF) will visit the community of Malamulele on Saturday, 8 December, during which the caring arm of government will provide a range of services. Crash victims can expect RAF staff to give the highest standard of care and professionalism when its Limpopo regional workforce set up a multi-functional office at **Malamulele Hospital**, from **08:00 to 16:00**.

At the heart of this community outreach is service delivery and making a difference to claimants' lives, including everyone affected by the scourge of road crashes. The following assistance will be provided: direct registering of new claims; consolidation of required claim compliance documents; settlement offers; reporting of cases involving alleged touting; and misappropriation of RAF payments by unscrupulous attorneys.

Community members are encouraged to bring their ID documents to the event for enquiries and information on their claim. Other important information required for new claims include police case numbers, accident reports, hospital reports, vehicle registrations, invoices, and details of other parties involved in the car crash.
